

# Lawton Undergraduate Retention Grant

Eligibility for this grant must be met. Second semester graduates may need to be checked as part of this review. If deemed eligible, your award will be reflected in your financial aid packages for the upcoming year. You may check your financial aid package via the Student Center on MyUW.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Lawton Undergraduate Retention Grant, you must meet the following criteria.

1. Resident of Wisconsin or Minnesota.
2. African-American, Latino, American Indian or statutorily designated Southeast Asian (Cambodian, Hmong, Laotian, Vietnamese) students who entered the U.S. after December 31, 1975.
3. Established financial need and have already applied for financial aid.
4. Minority status disclosed at time of registration.
5. Sophomore, junior, or senior status.
6. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.000; minimum GPA of 2.000 last semester in residence; not on academic probation or strict probation.
7. Must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress, carrying 12+ credits each semester. New applicants may be enrolled for 6 credits at the time of application, but should plan to complete 12 credits each succeeding semester. Special students and students working toward a second undergraduate degree are not eligible.
8. New transfer students must complete 6 or more credits at the UW-Madison campus to be eligible for the grant, unless they received the grant at another Wisconsin post-secondary institution.
